02 / About the Forum

The Global South Media and Think Tank Forum 2025 will be held in Yunnan Province, China from September 5 to 9. Under the theme "Empowering Global South, Navigating Global Changes," the Forum will bring together approximately 500 participants, representing over 260 institutions from 110 countries, as well as international and regional organizations. Bringing together delegates from media, think tanks, government agencies, academic institutions, and business communities, the Forum will facilitate in-depth exchanges focusing on four pivotal areas: building consensus on peace, identifying drivers of development, exploring new avenues of cooperation, and advancing dialogue among civilizations.

The Forum's agenda will feature the Opening Ceremony, the Plenary Session & the 4th Yunnan International Communication Forum, the Forum on AI Technology and Media, the Global South Think Tank Forum, the Tea Chat with Ambassadors in Yunnan & Global South Youth Dialogue, and the Global South World Heritage Forum. Key outcomes to be released during the event include *the Global South Media and Think Tank Forum Yunnan Consensus*, themed think tank report and publications. The Forum will also mark the official establishment of the Global South Joint Communication Partnership Network.

In November 2024, the inaugural Global South Media and Think Tank Forum was successfully convened in São Paulo, Brazil. Chinese President Xi Jinping sent

a congratulatory message to the event, calling for greater cooperation to advance the development of the Global South. Xinhua News Agency has since been working to build the forum into a collaborative platform with a focus on strengthening consensus, deepening exchanges and cooperation, amplifying the collective voice of the Global South, and enhancing its influence in global discourse. Over the past year, Xinhua has organized the ASEAN-China Media and Think Tank Forum in Malaysia, the China-Central Asia News Agencies Forum in Kazakhstan, and the BRICS Media and Think Tank Forum in Brazil. Xinhua will also host the Global South Media and Think Tank Forum: China-Africa Partnership Conference this November in South Africa.

03 / About the Organizers



Xinhua News Agency is China's state news agency as well as a global one. Founded in 1931 and headquartered in Beijing, Xinhua has nearly 13,000 employees in its over 220 domestic and overseas bureaus, with 184 of them located outside the Chinese mainland.

Xinhua has established a global news-gathering network and a multilingual, multimedia and multi-platform news dissemination system. As an all-media organization centered on news agency operation, it also engages in a wide range of media services.

Xinhua provides various news products featuring text, pictures, charts, social media content, and audio and video products in 15 languages for more than 8,000 news organizations around the world. It has signed news exchange and cooperation agreements or memoranda of understanding with mainstream media outlets and government institutions from over 130 countries and regions.

As a leading media think tank focusing on public policies and international affairs, Xinhua has conducted strategic, forward-looking and preparatory researches and strengthened cooperation with think tanks around the world. It led in the establishment of the Belt and Road Studies Network (BRSN). Notably, over 140 think tanks have joined this network as members.

Yunnan Province

Yunnan Province, referred to as “Yun” or “Dian”, is located in the southwestern border region of China, spanning 21°8’-29°15’ north latitude and 97°31’-106°11’ east longitude, with the Tropic of Cancer traversing its southern part. Covering a total area of 394,100km² (accounting for 4.1% of China’s total land area), it borders Guangxi Zhuang Autonomous Region and Guizhou Province to the east, faces Sichuan Province across the Jinsha River to the north, adjoins Xizang (Tibet) Autonomous Region in the northwest, shares a border with Myanmar to the west, and connects with Laos and Vietnam in the south and southeast respectively. Yunnan had 16 prefectures (cities) and 129 counties (cities and districts) under its administrative jurisdiction, with a total permanent resident population of 46.55 million by the end of 2024.

Yunnan Province features a mountainous plateau terrain with the highest point at an altitude of 6,740m and the lowest point at an altitude of 76.4m. It boasts 1,007 rivers each with a runoff area of over 100 km², along with 9 major plateau lakes. The region exhibits distinct seasonal characteristics: small temperature variations throughout the year but significant daily fluctuations, clearly defined dry and wet seasons, and diverse climate types with pronounced three-D climate characteristics. Yunnan is endowed with abundant energy resources, particularly rich in hydroelectric and coal reserves with excellent development potential. Its geological resources are exceptionally rich, renowned for its non-ferrous metals and phosphate deposits, earning it the title “Kingdom of Non-ferrous Metals.” Yunnan has the highest number of wild animal species in China and is known as the “Kingdom of Animals”. It is the province with the largest variety of plants in China, enjoying the reputation of the “Kingdom of Plants”, “Treasure House of Medicines”, “Hometown of Spices”, and “Natural Garden”. Yunnan is famous both at home and abroad for its unique plateau scenery, tropical and subtropical border scenery and colorful ethnic customs. In Yunnan Province, there are 671 national-level scenic spots above A level, 12 national-level scenic spots, 8 national-level famous historical and cultural cities, 22 national-level famous historical and cultural towns and villages, and 6 world heritage sites.

The Propaganda and Training Committee of the Party Central Committee was established in early 1951, it's an organisation of the Party at the central level that is equivalent to a commission of the Party Central Committee and a ministry of the state. The committee serves as the Secretariat for the Executive Committee, the Politburo, and the Secretariat of the Party Central Committee in the areas of ideology and politics, including explaining and disseminating the Party's guidelines, socio-economic development plans, state regulations and laws, as well as important events that affect ideology. The newspaper underwent a period of transformation in 2015 – 2016, navigating significant challenges—including a fire at its printing facility—with resilience and adaptability. Despite these setbacks, the Daily Mail sustained its reputation by maintaining high-quality print and online editions and continuously enhancing the features of its digital platform.



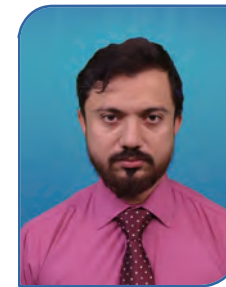

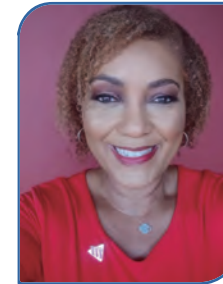

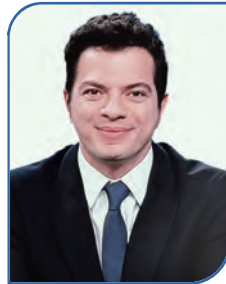
